



Interest Group Development

Kappa Delta Phi Fraternity takes pride in providing the opportunity for our members to develop into the leaders of tomorrow. A Kappa Man lives by his values every day, he holds himself and his Brothers to the highest standards and represents the best ideals of fraternalism. The first step toward becoming a Kappa Man involves the establishment of an interest group. To prepare an interest group to move into the colony stage the National Headquarters has developed several requirements focused on grades, growth, and generosity. These requirements establish a baseline from which an interest group can successfully transition into a Colony of Kappa Delta Phi.

All interest groups must petition the National Headquarters to receive approval to be recognized by Kappa Delta Phi. The petition should describe the members of the group, and how they have been working to meet the requirements stated below. The National Headquarters has made resources available for interest groups to help them in meeting these requirements in a timely manner.

Interest Group Requirements

Expanding Interest

- Participate in recruitment training provided by Fraternity Headquarters Staff
- Host two or more recruitment events
- Amass a recruitment 'names list' of at least 100 male candidates

Membership Development

- 80% of the interest group must attend a developmental event; the event should focus on personal/professional development, program planning, or academic achievement.
- Meet weekly to engage in brotherhood events to build fraternity spirit

Academic Achievement

- Group GPA above both the campus's All-Male and All-Fraternity Average GPAs
- Participate in weekly group study hours or other academic enrichment programs

Community Engagement

- Organize and conduct a philanthropy event benefiting a charitable organization (Kappa Delta Phi's National Philanthropy is Homes For Our Troops)
- Organize and conduct a service event benefiting the local community or the host institution
